Our mission is to provide a safe place for the children of Willits to play, grow and learn.

After School Programs

This is our eighth year of serving students after school. We began as a Tuesday afternoon club in spring of 2001, and then added a hiking club. In 2004, the Willits Unified School District approached us about partnering with them to offer a 5 day a week program for Brookside, Blosser Lane and Baechtel Grove Schools.

Today we serve almost 200 children a day, every day that school is open, until 6 PM.

Summer Programs

Since summer of 2001, Kids Club has offered day camps, giving children a chance to be outdoors and active in the summer time. We swim, hike, explore, do arts and crafts and go on field trips. Summer Camps are open to all children who have finished first grade to those who have finished seventh grade.
